#### READMISSION INTO CLASS XI – ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-13

Dear Parents,

1. I write to you to help you take a call on readmission of your son to class XI for AY 2012-13 at Mayo College.
2. Boys of class X wishing to continue with their studies at Mayo College in class XI require taking readmission. 45 to 50 boys of the existing Batch of class X will have to seek admission elsewhere as there are only 75 beds in the boarding houses for class XI.
3. Academic performance in class XI and XII is important as a good score achieved in these two classes are a stepping stone for admission into colleges and universities. Renowned colleges and universities give due weightage to a boy's school leaving certificate and recommendation letter.
4. Over the years our School has built a good faculty and has a well tested and structured schedule. The School has achieved the best results amongst the leading Public Schools in India. Therefore, in my opinion, Mayo should remain a preferred destination for your son's further studies. Let your son have a complete public school education and enjoy his childhood.
5. Industrious and focused boys manage their time well and are high achievers despite being deeply involved in games and extra curricular activities. Boys only need to pull out of Mayo if they require additional time at the desk or require parental guidance and monitoring.
6. During my interaction with class X boys last week it was discerned that for the next academic year there will be more boys seeking readmission than the vacancies in class XI. Therefore, there was a requirement to lay down fresh criteria for readmission as under.

**Note**

- **Grade to be calculated on marks obtained in FAs and SA-1.**
- **Additional Subject.**
  - Sec A, B, C & D will be given Physical Education / Painting as Sixth Subject.
  - \*\* Music will also be offered as the Sixth Subject once the School is registered with CBSE for Music.
- **Quota for Sports / Talent.** 15 % seats (10 seats) reserved for sportsmen. 10 % seats (7 seats) be reserved for boys who excel in co-curricular activities.
- **Old Boys' Wards.** - They will be given an advantage of 0.5 CGPA (approx 4.25%) increase in all the categories.

- **Discipline.** Not withstanding the minimum qualifying standards laid down, quota and concessions, the Principal can refuse re-admission to those boys who have not had a good track record in discipline at School.

7. The new academic session will start on 1 Apr 2012. You are requested to confirm whether your son would take readmission into class XI at Mayo College by email. Should he wish to seek readmission the same be intimated through a mail confirming the same followed by a bank draft of ₹ 1 lakhs in favour of Mayo College as caution money by 15 Dec 11. The caution money deposited would be adjusted against the school fee in case a boy is readmitted and refunded to those who do not get readmission. An early communication will help your child and enable the School to plan.

8. Parents will be informed of the readmission by 20 Mar 2012 i.e. after the marks of the FAs and SA-1 have been compiled and the merit drawn up.

9. I wish to reiterate that a coaching centre is not the answer for competitive results. We at Mayo have put in a schedule where a child seeking admission into an IIT or a medical college is ably supported in his endeavour. Do give this due consideration.
