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MAYO COLLEGE About the College

An all residential English medium boys' school from Class IV to Class XII, Mayo College Ajmer was founded in 1875 for the scions of the aristocracy of Rajputana, the princes of various states as well as their siblings who formed the nobility of the province to provide them with modern, liberal, enlightened and holistic education as a prerequisite for future rulers of imperial Rajputana.


Following Independence, it began to admit students from across the country and its societal spectrum. Today, its students are drawn from all over the globe. Where once Mayo College educated its boys to be rulers of their states and estates, it is now focused on producing leaders for all fields of life in modern societies.

The Main Building was completed in 1885 and was designed by Major Mant. The construction began in 1877 and was completed in 1885. Major Mant's design became a classic symbol of Indo-Saracenic architecture and apart from being quoted in architectural courses even today, the design now lies in the archives of the British Museum in London.

Nestled in the verdant valley of the Aravali Hills of Rajasthan, the School campus is 180 acres of the most luxuriant tree and grass cover at the start of the desert country. The Main Building constructed of marble is a classic example of IndoSaracenic architecture and stands tall. It has 18 full size playing fields, a 9-hole Golf course, 60 thoroughbred horses, a modern climbing wall, three gymnasiums, two swimming pools amongst other facilities and attracts students on exchange programmes from across the world.

GENERAL FORMAT AND RULES

- 1. Registration: The registration of the teams will take place at 1400H on Friday, 3rd October 2025.
- 2. **No Contest by Host Team for the Trophy:** Mayo College being the host team shall not contest for the Trophy but will compete for the individual positions.
- 3. **Code of Conduct:** Personal attack on a participant, offensive language, vulgar gestures or any other kind of indecorous conduct will lead to a severe point penalty or a team will be disqualified.
- 4. **Judging:** A panel of eminent persons will judge each event. The aggregate of the scores awarded by each judge will be considered as the final score of each participant.

FORMAT AND RULES (FOR AGES 11–13)

FRENCH SOLO SONG:

A. Purpose:

The purpose of solo song is to enhance artistic and language skills. This competition is also a means through which the student can learn French and Francophonie Culture.

- 1. The participant may choose any French song of their choice.
- 2. It is upon to the discretion of the participant whether they wish to sing with a printed copy of the lyrics or not. Marks will not be deducted even if they do so.
- 3. The participant may use the Karaoke version of the song for the background music or they may have someone play a music instrument for them.
- 4. The minimum and maximum time limit for a song will be 2 mins 30 secs and 4 mins respectively.
- 5. Kindly review the lyrics of the song to ensure that no foul or vulgar language is used. Please note that any performance containing such language will not be permitted.
- 6. The participant will be judged on the following criteria: -

FRENCH SPELL BEE (JUNIOR):

A. Purpose:

The purpose of a spell bee contest is to help students improve their spellings, enhance their vocabulary, learn concepts, and develop correct French usage that will help them throughout their lives.

- 1. Students will not be awarded any points for mistakes, even minor ones.
- 2. Participants will be provided with a note pad and a pencil. They are susupposed to write down the word before they spell it in all the rounds.
- 3. The spelling that is pronounced must match the one written on the note pad.
- 4. The participant shall not ask any questions or seek any information about the word.
- 5. Once the participant begins to spell a word, they cannot retract the spelling or rewrite or alter the letters or sequence of letters from those first uttered, otherwise no points will be awarded.





FORMAT AND RULES (FOR AGES 14–17)

FRENCH SOLO SONG:

A. Purpose:

The purpose of solo song is to enhance artistic and language skills. This competition is also a means through which the student can learn French and Francophonie Culture.

- 1. The participant may choose any French song of their choice.
- 2. It is upon to the discretion of the participant whether they wish to sing with a printed copy of the lyrics or not. Marks will not be deducted even if they do so.
- 3. The participant may use the Karaoke version of the song for the background music or they may have someone play a music instrument for them.
- 4. The minimum and maximum time limit for a song will be 2 mins 30 secs and 4 mins respectively.
- 5. Kindly review the lyrics of the song to ensure that no foul or vulgar language is used. Please note that any performance containing such language will not be permitted.
- 6. The participant will be judged on the following criteria: -

POETRY RECITATION:

A. Purpose:

The purpose of the poetry competition is to celebrate French language and convey a wide range of emotions and feelings.

- 1. One student per school.
- 2. Each participant will recite a poem of 2 to 3 minutes written by a French or Francophone Poet.
- 3. Reading out from a paper is not permitted.
- 4. The participants are allowed to use accessories and background music.
- 5. The participant will be judged on the following criteria:-

OLYMPIADE DE LA LANGUE FRANÇAISE:

A. Purpose:

The purpose of this event is to test the vocabulary and grammatical knowledge of the students. The level required corresponds to DELF A2.

B. Format: The questions will focus on:

Synonyms, antonyms, correct spelling of a word, correct conjugation in present and passé composé, correct order of the sentence, correct prepositions, articles, adjectives, masculine/feminine, singular/plural, image corresponding to the sentences, statements corresponding to the pictures etc.

C. Rules:

- I. One student per school.
- 2. There will be 40 multiple types of questions in French.
- 3. The selected option should be clearly indicated.
- 4. If the answer not selected clearly then he will be not awarded the point.
- 5. Any overwriting will be not acceptable.
- 6. The participant needs to submit the paper in the given time.
- 7. The organising committee will send 5 sample questions after the registrations.

FRANCOPHONE QUIZ:

A. Purpose:

The objective of the Quiz is to test the general knowledge about France and francophone countries.

- I. The questions of the quiz will revolve around General Information about Francophone Countries.
- 2. The questions can be in form of Images, Audio, Video etc.
- 3. The Number of the participant for quiz : a team of 2 participants from a school.
- 4. There will be two rounds. The 6 best teams will be qualified for the final round.





MAYO FILM FESTIVAL:

A. Purpose:

The Mayo French Film Festival aims to bring out the artist in the student along with promoting emotion and vocabulary learning in the language. It gives stage to all who can give voice and shape to their own story.

B. Topics:

Will be shared via mail after registration.

C. Rules:

- I. Each short film must be 7–10 minutes long and must be produced in the home country or in their own institute/school. The producer and director smust be present at time of judging. Any two actors can accompany them.
- 2. All dialogues must be in French. Use of English dialogues may lead to disqualification. It is also important to include English subtitles.
- 3. All content used in the film must be original. The use of outsourced videos, stock footage, or pre-existing content is strictly prohibited.
- 4. No lyrics or wording in any language other than English are permitted in the film, whether in songs, on-screen text, or elsewhere, except for English subtitles.
- 6. Any form of plagiarism is strictly prohibited and would result in immediate disqualification.
- 5. The film entries will be judged on the following criteria: -

FRANCOPHONE EXHIBITION:

A. Purpose:

An integral part of any festival relating to a particular culture or area is the celebration of that culture and traditions. In the event, "Les Pays Francophones", each team would be expected to set up a stall displaying the culture of a specific French–Speaking Country. Areas to be covered include: famous landmarks, cuisine, fashion, traditions and popular sports. Participants may also wear traditional garments to present their work.

- Schools that have already participated in 2022, 2023, and 2024 should select a different country than the one chosen in the previous three years.



FRANCOPHONE EXHIBITION:

Rules:

- 1. Two participants will be part of this event.
- 2. The teams will be given a booth each to show specialties of the selected Francophone country. The display can be of photos, famous landmark structure, famous cuisine, various famous products of that francophone country to make the display interesting.
- 3. The teams are requested to carry with them the traditional attire/costume of the allotted country.
- 4. The participants will be judged on the following criteria:

CUISINE FRANCOPHONE:

A. Eligibility:

- 1. The competition is open to students age group 14 to 17 years.
- 2. Each participating school can enter a team of two students.
- 3. Participants must be from the same school.
- 4. Each school can only register one team.

B. Competition Format:

- 1. The competition will consist of one round.
- 2. Each team will have to follow one given vegetarian recipe.
- 3. Recipe will be announced one month before the competition.
- 4. All necessary ingredients and cooking equipments will be provided by the organizing committee.





CUISINE FRANCOPHONE:

A. Changes to Rules:

- I. The organizing committee reserves the right to amend or modify the rules and regulations at any time.
- 2. Participants will be informed of any changes in advance.

B. Judging Criteria:

- 1. Judges' decisions are final and binding.
- 2. Dishes will be judged on the basis of the following criteria.
